

ANNEX to the GTS: "EXCLUDED AND SPECIAL GOODS"

WHAT SHIPMENTS WE DO NOT HANDLE (EXCLUDED GOODS)

- 1. We do not provide shipping services to Shipments that contain the following Goods (the Excluded Goods):
 - 1) live animals,
 - 2) securities,
 - 3) business-related documents and files,
 - 4) cash in any form (coins, banknotes),
 - 5) items of significant value or value that is difficult to determine,
 - for example: works of art, antiques, paintings, sculptures, gems, coins, precious stones, jewellery, valuables, precious metals
 - 6) resettlement property,
 - 7) mailings,
 - 8) dangerous goods (ADR) class 7 and subclass 6.2,
 - 9) corpses and human remains,
 - 10) goods subject to sanctions at the time of service, to the extent (including territorial) to which the sanctions apply.

WHAT SHIPMENTS WE CAN HANDLE AFTER THEY MEET SPECIAL CONDITIONS (SPECIAL GOODS)

- **2.** We can provide shipping services to Shipments that contain the following Goods (the Special Goods):
 - 1) plants,
 - 2) dual-use items, armaments, goods of strategic importance,
 - within the meaning of the Act of 29/11/2000 on foreign trade in goods, technologies, and services of strategic importance for state security, as well as for the maintenance of international peace and security
 - 3) bulk materials (packed in bulk),
 - 4) liquid materials (in tankers),
 - 5) goods and items that are particularly susceptible to damage in transit,
 - 6) waste, including municipal, medical, animal waste,
 - 7) goods or items that are damaged or whose condition or size prevents them from being properly transported by standard vehicles,
 - 8) goods that require a specialised vehicle and handling or non-standard packaging,

if applicable

- it is permitted by provisions of law, and
- prior to entering into the Agreement, you inform us of item, size, and characteristics of the Shipment in question and of the special aspects and requirements of its handling and transport, and
- we enter into an agreement with you in Writing.
